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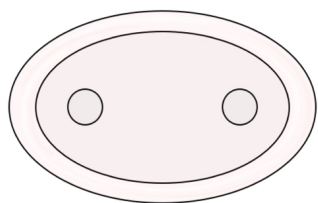
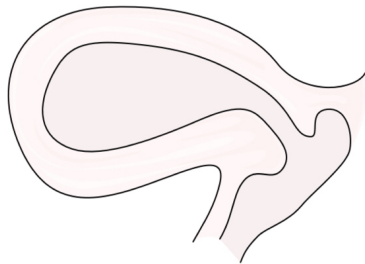
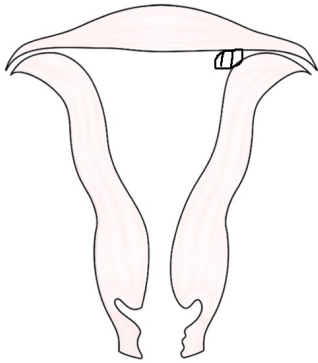

Position of the uterus: Anteverted

Cervix: Normal aspect

Isthmus: Normal

Hysterometry: 8 cm

Right ostrium: Seen

Left ostrium: Small trophoblastic retention in front of the ostium

Uterine cavity: Standard sizes and shapes

Endometrium: Normal aspect in relation to the cycle

Pathologies: Trophoblastic retention

Biopsy: Not carried out

Pain: 5

Dilatation: None

Method of anesthesia: Without anesthesia

Conclusion and comments: Normal hysteroscopy. A small trophoblastic retention obstructing the left fallopian tube which resection is to be discussed.

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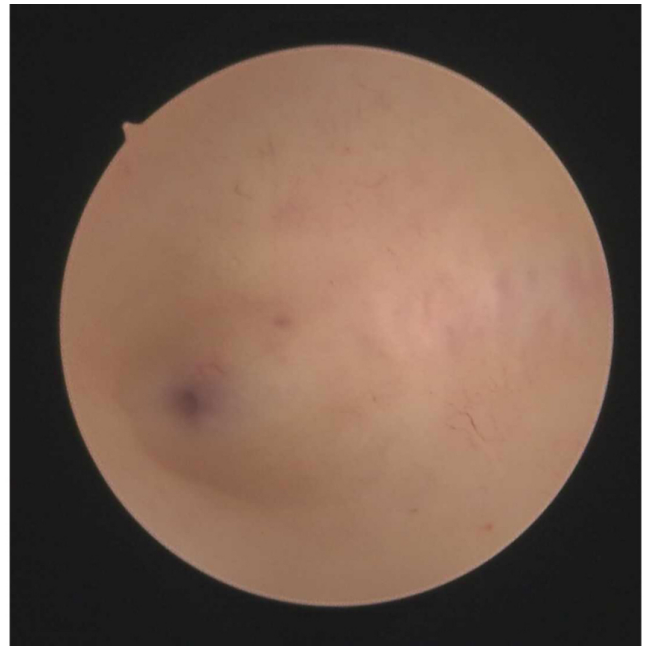
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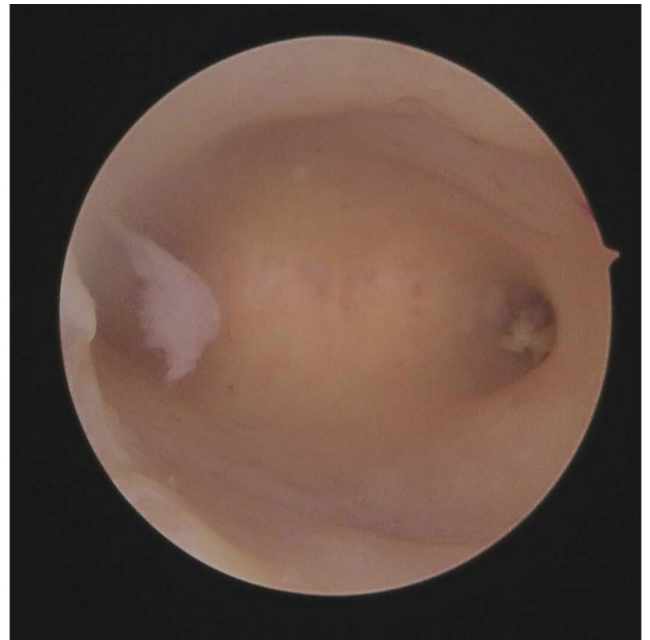
Left ostrium
